## TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN POLICE

**SUBJECT:** Residential Burglary and an Attempted Residential Burglary

**DATE/TIME:** See narrative.

**LOCATION:** Milwin Court / Lakeview Ave

**ACCUSED:** Jaheem Workman 19 year old male from the City of Asbury Park  
A 15 year old male from Neptune Township

**NARRATIVE:** On Tuesday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 7:44 AM, township police investigated a residential burglary on Milwin Court. An unknown suspect(s) entered the unlocked residence sometime late Monday July 25<sup>th</sup> or in the morning hours of the 26<sup>th</sup>. The house was occupied by family members who were sleeping during the burglary. While in the residence jewelry was stolen. Officer John Goncalves and Detective Jeffrey Malone are handling the investigation.

On Wednesday, July 27, 2011, at 2:30 AM township police responded to a Lakeview Avenue residence where a resident spotted two individuals dressed in all black on a neighbor's deck. The subjects fled prior to police arrival. A search of the area was conducted. One subject was apprehended walking on Wickapecko Drive after refusing officers initial orders to stop. The second subject was found hiding on Lincoln Drive at Park Place. Both subjects matched the description as provided by the caller. An on scene investigation revealed that they were attempting to gain entry into a Lakeview Avenue residence. Both subjects were taken into custody and subsequently transported to the station for processing.

One of the subjects a 15 year old male from Neptune Township was released to a parent pending juvenile delinquency complaints. Jaheem Workman a 19 year old male from Asbury Park was the second subject. He was charged with, Criminal Attempt Burglary, Criminal Mischief Possession of Burglar Tools and Obstruction. He was remanded to the Monmouth County Correctional Institution after defaulting on his bail, which was set at \$5,000.00 Handling the investigation was Officer's Alon Bercovicz, Randy Slawsky and Detective Jeffrey Malone.
