NARRATIVE

On 9-8-09 at approximately 1:12 am, police were called to a Lawrence Ave residence in reference to subjects damaging a vehicle. The caller advised that four male subjects were in a black Ford F-250 pick up and were pulled up along side his 2005 Mustang. Two of the males were seen in the bed of the pick up truck and damaged the Mustang by punching the side view mirror off and kicking the door panel. As the caller ran out the pick up fled the area. Officers arrived in the area but did not immediately locate the pick up. While checking the area officers did find three other vehicles that had the side mirrors damaged, a 2005 Porsche Cayenne, a 1993 Lincoln and a 2002 Mercury. All three vehicles were parked on Berger Ave. Neighboring police departments were notified of the incident and to be on the look out for the pick up truck. A short time later the West Long Branch Police found the pick up truck and the four male subjects identified as **Christopher Mooney, Brian M. England, Marcus A. Mandeville and William J. Budinich**, on Cedar Ave. The four were taken into custody and turned over to the Ocean Township Officers. The Ford F-250 was subsequently seized under state criminal forfeiture guidelines.

Each was charged with four counts of Criminal Mischief and later released on a criminal summons.
