**Registration:** On Wednesday, March 2 (spring cycle) and Wednesday, May 4 (summer cycle) registrations will be accepted on-line (using credit card payments) through CommunityPass, our new on-line registration service. Non-residents may register as per the non-resident dates indicated in the brochure.

It is strongly suggested that our residents avoid waiting in line and take advantage of the on-line registration procedure. However, in person registration will be accepted for the spring cycle on March 2 and the summer cycle on May 4 at the **Department of Human Services, 601 Deal Rd.** beginning @ 8:30 a.m. Staff will register walk-ins, in the order in which they are received, using the on-line program. Registrants are expected to remain on site until the process is completed. Registration forms/fees received by mail prior to the publicized registration dates will go unprocessed and will be considered for processing as openings permit.

### **Park Regulations:**

Please be considerate of the following park regulations for the enjoyment of all who visit the facilities and do not hesitate to report any concerns regarding parks and playgrounds to the Department of Human Services at 732-531-2600.

Park Hours: 7:00 a.m. - sunset

Pets must be leashed at all times.

Parking is permitted in designated areas only.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted unless special arrangements are made at Dept. of Human Services.

Please clean up after your pet.

Golfing is not permitted on softball fields or soccer fields.

Dispose of trash & recyclables using appropriate containers.

A complete listing of Park Regulations can be found in Chapter XVI of the General Ordinances of the Township of Ocean. The above noted hours do not pertain to the Municipal Gym, Ocean Community Pool & Tennis Facility or Municipal Golf Course.

### **Tennis Court Reservation & Use Procedure:**

- Courts are located at Wanamassa, Wayside and Oakhurst Parks and are available for use from 8:00 a.m. to dusk. Courts at the Pool and Tennis Facility are limited to use by members or those who pay the daily fee.
- Residents may reserve court time at Oakhurst, Wanamassa and Wayside parks April 15 - October 11, during which time reservations will be posted daily.
- Players are limited to reserving one hour of court time per day up to three days in advance by contacting the Recreation Office. Monday through Friday, before 3:45 p.m. (Court time scheduled on the hour). Reservations ARE NOT accepted for the same day as the call. Player's name will be requested at time of reservation. Reservation sheets will be posted each morning at the above mentioned parks.
- Walk-ons can play on a first come basis if court is not previously reserved. Walk-on use is limited to an hour (on the hour) if others are waiting to play. Walk-ons must vacate the courts any time they are reserved.

### **Softball Field Use:**

Residents may reserve a softball field (2 hour blocks of time). Reservations accepted no more than a week in advance of requested date. Fields are available for use as of April 15th (weather permitting). Contact the Recreation Office for additional information/requirements.

Fees apply for use of the softball & baseball field at the Wanamassa Fireman's Memorial Park Complex.

## Registration for programs offered by the Township of Ocean Recreation Office can be completed on-line using a credit card!

*If you have already established a Family Account you will just need your User Name and Password to register on-line for upcoming programs. If you've forgotten this information, please contact the Recreation Office @ 732-531-2600 prior to the spring or summer registration dates and that information will be computer generated and forwarded to the email address you provided on your Family Account.*

If you have not previously used this on-line registration procedure during a prior registration period, please follow the easy steps below. No more waiting on lines, no more missed deadlines. You can now register 24/7 on a secure site.

### What you need to know...

1. Create your family account using CommunityPass. You can reach CommunityPass following the simple instructions below. On-line transactions require a credit card (Mastercard or Visa) and a valid email address.
2. For the **spring cycle** of recreation activities, on-line registration will begin **Wednesday, March 2nd @ 8:30 a.m.** Registration for the **summer cycle** of activities will begin **Wednesday, May 4th @ 8:30 a.m.** During that time, you can follow the simple instructions found here or on the site to login, register and pay online. Non-residents may also register on-line during the established non-resident registration dates.

### Registering is Fast & Easy...Here's How...

From any computer with an internet connection, go to [www.oceanhsd.org](http://www.oceanhsd.org) and click on **Recreation Registration** to begin or logon directly to <https://register.communitypass.net/oceantwp>. Click on "Create Your Account Now".

#### **Step 1**

Sign Up by completing the Log In Information & Family Information sections and click on "Continue". Your family account is now set up and you are back at the CommunityPass homepage.

#### **Step 2**

From the drop down box above "Register Now!" select the appropriate activity category; **Spring 2011 Recreation Programs, Summer 2011 Recreation Programs, 2011 Ocean Community Pool and Tennis Facility, etc.** and click "Register Now". (Only current activities for which we are accepting registrations will display in the drop down box).

#### **Step 3 Verify Account:**

Verify your general family account information is accurate.

#### **Step 4 Select Participants:**

Use this screen to add other family members (ie. spouse, children) not yet listed; click on "Add New Child" or "Add New Adult". When done entering family members, select those family members that you are interested in registering for a program and click "Continue".

**We suggest that you always select all family members so you can review all programs available to all members of the family.**

#### **Step 5**

From the "Profile Verification" page, enter the required information for each individual you are registering (ie. appropriate grade, dates of birth). When finished, click on the "Continue" button. **You can always reference where you are in the registration process by viewing the menu posted on the left side bar.**

#### **Step 6**

A list of age/grade appropriate program(s) for each family member will display. Click on the activities for which you want to register. You can view specific program information by clicking on **detail** to the right of the program name. #### **Step 7**

Please follow the remaining instructions on your screen to complete and pay for your registration. CommunityPass will calculate your cost on your confirmation page. Payment for online transactions is accepted with a credit card (Visa or Mastercard) only.

## In-Person or Mail-in Registration Form

1. On March 2 (spring cycle), & May 4 (summer cycle) registration will begin @ 8:30 a.m. online or in person at the **DEPT. of HUMAN SERVICES**.
2. Registration takes place during dates specified in the brochure and will be accepted on a first come basis until maximum enrollment is met. Forms received by mail prior to registration opening will be returned unprocessed. **Once maximum enrollment for program is met, registration will close.** If a minimum requirement is not met, program may be cancelled.
3. Loch Arbor residents are invited to register for programs offered through the Recreation Office and held in the Twp. of Ocean school(s), prior to other non-resident registration date(s) as noted for the program. Registrations accepted if space is available. Registration for other non-residents will be accepted beginning on the non-resident registration date indicated, if space is available.
4. In person registrations are accepted at the Recreation Office from 8:30 – 4:30, Mondays through Fridays. Registration **are not** accepted on site at programs.
5. For walk-in or mail in registrations, form must be completed and submitted with the designated fee in order to be registered for a program. Incomplete forms will be returned unprocessed. Please use one form per person per program. Staff will register walk-ins in the order in which they are received, using the online program. Registrants are expected to remain onsite until the process is completed.
6. All checks payable to: **Township of Ocean** (unless otherwise specified).
7. Age requirements must be met by program starting date. Copy of participant's birth certificate may be requested.
8. Program refunds will be granted only if the program is cancelled by the Recreation Office (no service charge will apply) or if the vacated spot can be filled prior to the start of the program. Request for refund must be made in writing. Refunds will not be considered following the start of a program. Granted refunds will be assessed a \$10.00 service charge. Requests for refunds received within the appropriate time frame may also be credited to the registrant's Family Account (with no processing charge held) and applied to a future activity.
9. The Township of Ocean has established a Participation Code of Conduct (copy available upon request and posted on Township website). Compliance is required for participation in activities.
10. Photos & videos of activities sponsored by the Department of Human Services may be used on Ocean TV cable station and in other forms of publicity.
