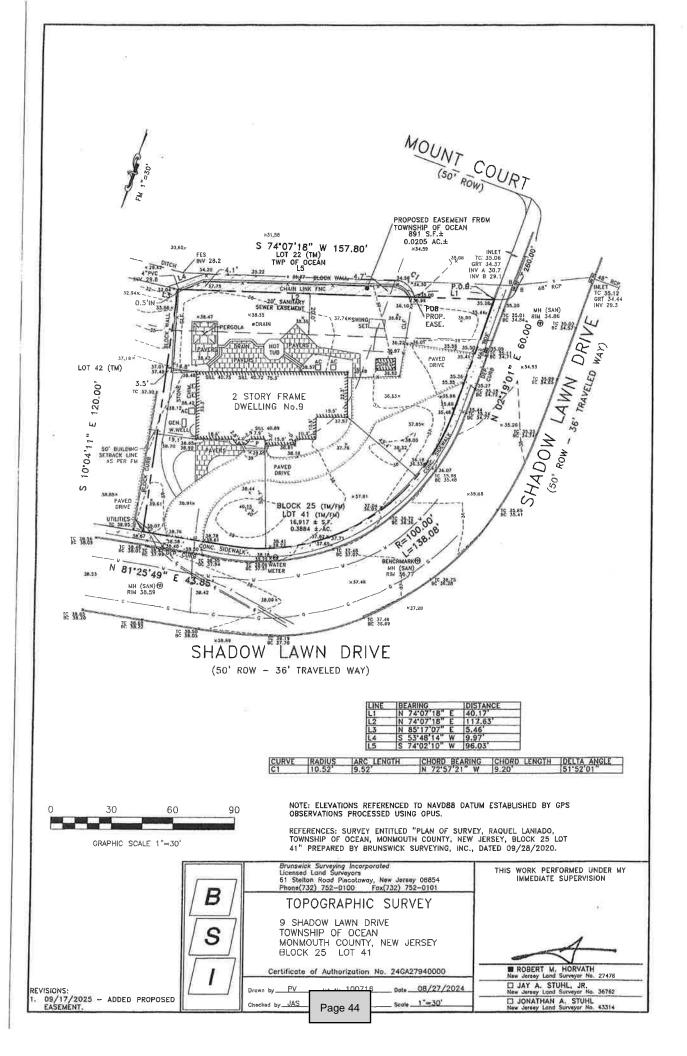

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township of Ocean, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that Chapter II, Section 9 entitled "Personnel Policies, Practices and Procedures", of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Ocean, 1965" are hereby amended ad supplemented as follows:

### SECTION I

# **ARTICLE X – EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES**

# X-7 Cell Phone Policy

# A. Purpose/Scope

This policy establishes guidelines for the appropriate use of personal and municipal-issued cell phones to ensure employee productivity, maintain public trust, and safeguard sensitive or confidential information in the service of the community. This policy applies to all full-time, part-time, temporary, and contract employees including elected officials and department heads, where applicable.

## B. Personal Cell Phone Use During Work Hours

## Permitted Use:

- During scheduled breaks and meal periods
- For emergency communications
- For brief, infrequent personal calls or texts, provided it does not interfere with work responsibilities
- All work-related communications on personal devices may be subject to public disclosure
- Employees are responsible for forwarding any public record communications from personal devices to the appropriate municipal system (e.g., email archiving)

# <u>Prohibited Use</u>:

- While serving the public or engaging in community-facing duties (e.g., reception, field inspections, meetings)
- During official meetings, unless directly related to work
- For extended personal conversations or social media use during work hours
- While operating government vehicles or heavy machinery (unless hands-free and work-related)

<u>Note</u>: All work-related communications on personal devices may be subject to public disclosure. Employees are responsible for forwarding any public record communication from personal device to appropriate municipal system.

# C. Municipal-Issued Cell Phones

# Employees provided with a municipal-issued cell phone must:

- Use the device primarily for official municipal business
- Keep the phone secure and password-protected
- Avoid excessive personal use
- Return the device upon separation from the municipality or reassignment

<u>Note</u>: Devices may be subject to public disclosure under the New Jersey Open Records Act (OPRA) and/or Freedom of Information (FOI) legislation, as well as the Common Law Right to Know.

# D. Use While Driving

<u>In accordance with local and state/provincial traffic laws:</u>

- Employees must use hands-free devices if using a cell phone while driving on municipal business
- Texting or manual use while driving is strictly prohibited

# E. Violations and Disciplinary Action

# <u>Violations of this policy may result in:</u>

- Verbal or written warnings
- Revocation of municipal-issued device privileges
- Disciplinary action up to and including termination
- Potential civil or legal penalties if misuse results in a breach of public records laws

# F. Policy Exceptions

# Exceptions may be granted by Department Heads or the HR Director for:

- Employees in on-call or emergency services roles (e.g., Public Works, Police, Fire, OEM, Utilities)
- Special accommodations (e.g., medical needs)
- Elected officials, as applicable to their duties

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, 1965" ENTITLED: EXCAVATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC STREETS

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Ocean in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter VIII of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Ocean, 1965" entitled: "Excavation and Construction of Public Streets" shall be amended as follows; additions to the current ordinance are noted in <u>underline</u>; deletions are noted by <u>strikethrough</u>.

### SECTION I

### § 8-3. STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR STREETS AND SIDEWALKS.

## § 8-3.2. Sidewalks.

Sidewalks shall have a minimum thickness of four inches nominal and a minimum width of four feet. Sidewalks shall be constructed at the locations and to the prescribed lines and grades as directed by the township engineer but shall be constructed after the adjacent curb has first been installed. The subgrade shall be smooth and even and shall be compacted by rolling, after which gravel shall be spread to a depth of not less than three inches, and compacted. Concrete for sidewalks shall have a twenty-eight-day compressing strength of 3,500 4500 P.S.I. and shall be air-entrained. Only one brand of cement shall be used, except where authorized in writing by the township engineer. The finish shall be with a wood float followed by brushing with a set, soft-haired brush, to a neat, workmanlike surface. Expansion joints, one-half inch wide, shall be provided at intervals of 20 feet or less and filled with pre-formed bituminous cellular type and pre-formed bituminous type joint filler. Surface grooves shall be cut perpendicularly to the line of the sidewalk at intervals equal to its width. Exposed edges shall be neatly rounded to a radius of one-half inch. Aprons for driveways shall be of the same material as herein specified for curbs and shall be constructed to a six-inch minimum normal thickness with welded wire fabric reinforcing and shall in no event extend in the driveway toward the house a distance of more than five feet from the back of the curb lines, at which point the top surface of the apron shall be level with the top of the curb. The top surface elevation, at the intersection of the house side of the sidewalk and the driveway apron, shall be the same.

## **SECTION II**

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining part of this Ordinance.

### **SECTION III**

Any Ordinance or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and superseded.

### **SECTION IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with Law.

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, 1965" ENTITLED: EXCAVATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC STREETS, TO ADD A PENALTY PROVISION FOR VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 8-1.8 of the Township Code currently prohibits road openings within 5 years after a street is paved, unless a permit is approved based on public health or safety, or unless an emergency condition exists, but the section contains no provision for any penalty for violation of this section; and

**WHEREAS,** the Mayor and Council desire to ensure the enforceability of the prohibition in Section 8-1.8 by enacting a provision for penalties for violations thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Ocean as follows:

### **SECTION I**

Chapter VIII of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Ocean, 1965" entitled: Excavation and Construction of Public Streets, is hereby amended and supplemented to add the following new Section 8-1.11, to be entitled "Violations and Penalties":

# § 8-1. EXCAVATION

# § 8-1.11. Violations and Penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$2,000 or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during which a violation occurs or continues.

### **SECTION II**

All Ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

### **SECTION III**

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XI OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, 1965" ENTITLED: HEALTH, TO ADD A SECTION TO PROHIBIT THE ILLEGAL SALE OF CANNABIS AND INTOXICATING HEMP PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the legalization of cannabis through the Cannabis Regulatory Enforcement Assistance and Market Modernization Act, P.L.2021, c.16 ("CREAMM Act") has introduced new concerns regarding the unregulated sale of cannabis products; and

**WHEREAS,** despite the CREAMM Act's provisions for the legal sale of cannabis products with a proper Class 5 Retail License, some retail stores and smoke shops have been selling or advertising cannabis products and paraphernalia without obtaining the necessary cannabis licenses; and

WHEREAS, given the proliferation of businesses attempting to sell cannabis items without proper oversight, the Township of Ocean finds that regulations are warranted to clearly establish and enforce the prohibition of the illegal sale and distribution of cannabis and intoxicating hemp products and paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, this chapter shall not affect the legal sale of the above products and paraphernalia by businesses that hold a valid cannabis retail license with the State of New Jersey and approved by the Township of Ocean; and

**WHEREAS,** these findings demonstrate the necessity of implementing clear and enforceable regulations governing cannabis in the Township of Ocean; and

**WHEREAS,** the CREEAM Act authorizes municipalities to enact ordinances or regulations governing the location, manner and times of operations of cannabis establishments and distributors, and to establish civil penalties for violation of such ordinances or regulations, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 24:6I-45.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN:

### **SECTION I**

Chapter XI of the Township Code of the Township of Ocean, entitled "Health," is hereby amended and supplemented to add a new Section 11-10, to be entitled "Prohibition of CBD and THC Infused Food Products," and which shall read as follows:

§ 11-10. PROHIBITION OF CBD AND THC INFUSED FOOD PRODUCTS.

### § 11-10.1. Definitions.

The following terms as used in this Section shall have the following meanings:

"CBD and THC infused food products" shall mean any food product, whether homemade or commercially produced, that contains cannabidiol (CBD) or tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) as an active ingredient and shall include CBD and THC infused candy, drinks, or liquid edibles.

"Cannabis paraphernalia" shall mean means any equipment, products, or materials of any kind used, intended for use, or designated for use in activities involving the cultivation, processing, or consumption of cannabis, including but not limited to planting, propagating, harvesting, manufacturing, testing, packaging, storing, and ingesting.

"Intoxicating hemp product" shall mean the term as defined in N.J.S.A. 24:6I-33 and N.J.A.C. 2:25-1.2, which includes products with tetrahydrocannabinols (THC) Delta-8 and Delta-10 that exceed the State's limit of total THC concentration per package.

"Intoxicating hemp paraphernalia" shall mean any equipment, products, or materials of any kind used, intended for use, or designed for use in activities involving the cultivation, processing, or consumption of intoxicating hemp, including but not limited to planting, propagating, harvesting, manufacturing, testing, packaging, storing, and ingesting.

# § 11-10.2. Prohibition of Sale, Marketing, Distribution and Consumption.

# A. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to:

Display or advertise any cannabis and cannabis paraphernalia, or intoxicating hemp products or intoxicating hemp produce paraphernalia, in any manner visible from the exterior of any premises, including, but not limited to, signage, advertisements, outdoor display, exterior windows, transparent paneling, or display boxes.

Sell, offer for sale, or distribute for commercial purposes, at no cost, minimal cost, or with coupons or rebate offers, any cannabis and cannabis paraphernalia, or intoxicating hemp product or intoxicating hemp paraphernalia, anywhere other than a cannabis business legally licensed and regulated pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:61-31 et seq., and Chapter 5-16 of the Code of the Township of Ocean. This includes, but is not limited to, retail stores, convenience stores, smoke shops, or any other establishment that is not licensed by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission.

Assist, aid or abet any person, irrespective of profit, in obtaining or possessing, or possessing or possession of CBD or THC infused food products to persons under 21 years of age.

B. The consumption of cannabis or any cannabis product shall be prohibited in any public or private establishment, including, but not limited to, convenience stores, smoke shops, retail stores, or any place not specifically licensed for cannabis consumption.

# § 11-10.3. Violations and Penalties.

Any person convicted of a violation of any part of this Section shall be subject to a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), but not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for each separate offense.

### § 11-10.4. Consistent with State Law.

This Section shall be construed consistently with the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance and Marketplace Modernization Act (P.L.2021, c.16) and regulations adopted thereunder.

### **SECTION II**

All Ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
